

2. The challenges in NCDs management amid COVID-19

- Difficulties in accessing chronic disease management services due to social distancing (Ha Loi hamlet, Me Linh commune, Me Linh district – Hanoi; Dong Van town - Ha Giang province, Danang, Hai Duong...).
- People who exposed to COVID-19 patients (F1, F2 ...) are isolated in medical facilities or Field Hospitals (ex: National Hospital of Tropical Diseases, Cu Chi Hospital ...).
- Stop receiving new patients, Stop supply services for NCDs: Hospitals went into lockdown after detecting healthcare workers/patients have COVID-19 (ex: Hong Ngoc Hospital, Bach Mai Hospital...) .
- Patients are concerned about the Covid-19, they don't visit health facilities).

April 8th - May 4th : Hạ Lôi hamlet, Mê Linh commune , Hanoi (with population at 11.000 people) went into lockdown due to detecting some new COVID-19 cases related to COVID-19 patient no. 243: interdisciplinary team (policeman, healthcare worker, military, youth volunteers) on 24/24 duty.
